# Course:

To be successful in this course, you will need to attend class on a regular basis, do all assigned homework, be prepared for class by bringing materials, ask questions, and have a good attitude. These things will not only make you successful in this class, but also in life.

This is the first year of our newly adopted math series, GoMath. It is workbook-style textbook that contains both the textbook and the homework. **MANY** additional math materials are available online, including homework help, instructional videos, student text, and other helpful items. Parents, I will review this site with the students, but they will probably need to review the site more thoroughly with you. During the first week of class, you will receive a login ID and password for the website which is located at http://my.hrw.com.

One of your greatest reference tools is your math book; however, the book is not a substitute for being at school. Everyone will be issued a math book that will stay in the classroom. At the start of each new unit, you will remove the entire unit and place it in the bradded folder, which may be taken home for homework and study.

# <u>Classroom Rules/Absences/Makeup Work:</u>

School rules and classroom rules are posted in the room. I will go over rules and procedures the first week of school. Please refer to the student handbook for our

school's discipline plan, procedures, and expectations.

It is the student's responsibility to get makeup work upon return from an absence. Each lesson and assignment will be posted on my class website under the Calendar/Homework. Each day's lesson notes can be found by clicking on the appropriate lesson link.

## Homework/Class Work Policy:

You are expected to come to class prepared to learn. This means having homework assignments completed BEFORE class starts every day, having a pen, a pencil, paper, and a good attitude. We all have "bad days" from time to time, but let's **all** make a conscious effort to leave any discouraging words, thoughts, and attitudes at the door. Also, I will drop the lowest homework grade each 6 weeks.

Homework must be completed in pencil, and all problems must be written down, worked out and at least **attempted** in the way shown in class in order to receive credit for the assignment. **YOU MUST SHOW ALL WORK ON HOMEWORK, TESTS, AND QUIZZES TO RECEIVE CREDIT!** Please make sure that you bring a pen to class every day (any color except black) for checking homework assignments. If the homework is not complete, the student will be sent to detention the next day to complete the assignment and will receive no higher than a 70%.

## <u>Multiplication Facts:</u>

You MUST know your multiplication facts through the 10's. It is **ESSENTIAL** that you know these facts as soon as possible, because much of what we do in 7<sup>th</sup> grade math assumes that you know them. If you are having trouble memorizing them, please see me and I can give you some strategies to help. There will also be some flashcards in the room that students may use to study.

### **Grading:**

Grades will consist of tests, quizzes, homework, and class work. Homework, quizzes and daily work will be 70% and tests will be 30% of the final grade.
